

The Lord God said: "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a suitable partner for him." 

4. Chris Volpe says that "fertility is a healthy thing..." and therefore it is a contradiction to take something that would interfere with the natural, healthy functioning of her body.


► As a woman, what does that mean for you? As a man, what does that say to you?

WHAT EXACTLY IS NFP?


- 1. Natural Family Planning is an umbrella term for those natural methods used to achieve or postpone pregnancy by reading the signs of a woman's fertility.
 - ► Have you considered NFP as a means to plan the size and the spacing of your family?
- 2. Dr. Jennifer DeMarco says that the beauty of NFP is that you are giving freely to your spouse and inviting God into your marriage.
 - ► Do you feel that God is present in your relationship? Why or why not? If yes, in what ways is He present?
- 3. Matthew DeMarco says that the Catholic teaching on marriage and sexuality is a "return to Eden" and that each and every act of sexual union is the two of you joining together with God.
 - ► Read Genesis 2:4-25 (p. 14) and discuss the DeMarco's comments. What are the implications for your own relationship?
 - ► Discuss how sexuality is connected to the sacrament of marriage.

Using NFP means that as a couple you must re-evaluate on a monthly basis your reasons (related to finances, work situation, health, etc.) for being open to, or for postponing, pregnancy.

EVERYONE KNOWS THAT NFP DOESN'T WORK


- 1. How does the popular media and culture shape your understanding of sexuality?
